

POOL AND SPA RULES AND GUIDELINES

The pool is intended for the private recreational use of the residents in good standing and their invited guests. Since there are no lifeguards in attendance at the pool, it is a "<u>MEMBERS AND GUESTS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK"</u> facility. Each pool user is expected to conduct themselves so that their behavior at no time detracts from the peaceful enjoyment to which other residents are entitled.

HOURS: 7 A.M. TO 10 P.M.

<u>GATE KEYS</u>: One key per household will be provided by the Association Management Customer Service upon request by Owner.

<u>GUESTS</u>: Guests are limited to five (5) per household, not including homeowners, and must be accompanied by a resident while using the pool.

All trash, cigarette butts, etc. must be disposed of in waste containers provided for that purpose. Each resident is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and guests.

No sound amplification devices (radios, "boom boxes", CD players, etc.) are allowed unless their sound is delivered to individual listeners through headsets or headphones. An exception is music provided as part of an approved party (wherein reservations have been made in advance with the Pool Committee). In no event is any sound projection in conjunction with a party to occur past 9 p.m. on any day of the week.

HEATING OF POOL & SPA:

Because heating the pool during the winter months would considerably increase the monthly utility expenditure, the Board of Directors has adopted the following policy:

The Villas at Granite Bay swimming pool will be heated only during the colder months of the year at the discretion of the Board of Directors. The spa will continue to be heated year round until further notice.



POOL AND SPA RULES

- 1. No running, pushing or "horseplay" of any kind in the pool area.
- 2. No diving into the pool at any time.
- 3. Individuals under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 or older. (State Law) Persons less than 48" in height, or who are not competent swimmers MUST BE ATTENDED BY A QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL WHO IS IN THE WATER WITH THEM.
- 4. Persons 5 years of age or younger are not to be in the spa at any time- NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. We recommend that you not use the spa if you are pregnant, have a heart condition, suffer from dizziness, are intoxicated or on medication. You should consult with your physician if you have any questions.
- 6. No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the pool area at any time. All beverage containers used in the pool area must be of unbreakable material.
- 7. No cooking of food is permitted in the pool area,
- 8. No eating, drinking or smoking is permitted in the pool
- 9. No pets are allowed in the enclosed pool area.
- 10. No skateboards, skates, rollerblades or bicycles are allowed in the pool area.
- 11. Only swimsuits are allowed in the pool; no cut-offs or street clothing.
- 12. Swimmers must shower before entering the pool to remove any suntan oil, ointment or dirt.
- 13. In the interest of public health, it is recommended that adults supervising any child under the age of 14 require the child(ren) to vacate the pool once each hour to visit appropriate restrooms as needed. Other pool users will appreciate this. CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT "POTTY TRAINED" MUST WEAR A SECURE PROTECTIVE RUBBER PANT TO MINIMIZE POOL CONTAMINATION AT ALL TIMES. A disposable diaper does not meet this restriction. It is also recommended that adults with incontinence problems do the same.
- 14. Personal flotation devices are permitted provided they remain attached to the individual swimmer.
- 15. Flotation devices, pool toys, etc. are permitted provided the item is no longer than two feet in length at its longest dimension. The commonly used Styrofoam flotation devices referred to as "Noodles" are allowed so long as swimmers keep them under control and do not abuse other swimmers with them. Toys of any type are not permitted in the spa. Items such as rocks or coins are not to be thrown into the pool/spa at any time.
- 16. No boats or watercraft of any type, powered or unpowered are permitted.

- 17. Snorkels, fins or masks may be worn while the swimmer is in the water. They may not be left in the pool.
- 18. No scuba gear is allowed in the pool or pool area.
- 19. No climbing over pool fences, gates or furniture is allowed.
- 20. Gates to the pool area are to be kept closed and locked.
- 21. Pool furniture is to be used only for the purpose for which it is designed. Furniture is not to be used for games or other activities.
- 22. Pool furniture may not be removed from the pool area at any time.
- 23. Life preservers, body hooks and safety lines/floats are for emergency use only. They may not be used for recreational play at any time.
- 24. Each resident and pool user is expected to use the pool facility in such a way that the other users' enjoyment of the facility is not negatively impacted.

FAILURE OF A RESIDENT TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF POOL PRIVILEGES AND/OR FINES.
